Today's Prayer Requests: From Students, Alumni, and Missionaries

SENEGAL: Senegal is the westernmost nation on the African continent, and more than 95% of its people follow Islam. A WAAS professor and leader in the Assemblies of God of Senegal shares these prayer requests:

- Pray for the young people of Senegal. Many are losing interest in Islam and are open to the gospel. However, most fear retribution from their parents, who are ashamed if their children become Christians. Pray that the Lord would work in the spirits of the parents to free their children. Pray that the youth would be captivated by the gospel of love.
- Pray for Kid's Clubs held in AG churches throughout the nations. More than 100,000 children are involved during the school year. Pray that more such clubs would be established in the villages.
- The Assemblies of God of Senegal runs a dozen schools connected to churches, including a school for deaf/dumb and a high school. Because these schools offer better education, parents are eager to send their children. Pray that these youngsters would come to know Jesus and be lights to their families and communities. Pray for God's strength and blessing on the teachers.
- Intercede for missionaries working in little-reached areas of the nation. Praise God, with the arrival of a missionary family from another West African nation, there is now an AG presence in all 14 regions. Four families from another nation are working in the north, and a Senegalese couple have gone to the Soninke people in the southeast. Pray for fruitful ministry for them and others working in these challenging areas.

2016 World Watch List: Pakistan*

Pakistan ranks 6th on the list of countries where Christians face the most persecution. Even though freedom of religion is guaranteed and churches meet freely, believers live in constant and justified fear of false accusations of blasphemy against Mohammed or the Koran. Women in particular face the threats of kidnapping, forced conversions to Islam, forced marriages, and honor killings. Intercede for our brothers and sisters, that they would walk daily in the wisdom of the Holy Spirit and stand strong in their faith.
