Today's Prayer Requests: From Students, Alumni, and Missionaries

CAMEROON: Pray for a radio ministry reaching Muslims here, that God would give the producers and presenters wisdom. Their methodology is to present a story to capture interest, leading to a spiritual, biblical application and gospel message.

SENEGAL: A student asks us to pray concerning a Christian radio broadcast in the Wolof language. This program is heard a town that is an important stronghold of Islam in this nation. Every time the producers of the program visit this town, they find people hungry for the Good News they are hearing. Pray that the Lord would bless this effort and bring many into His kingdom through this ministry, and for a spiritual breakthrough among the very resistant Wolof.

In the News

Hundreds of Christian refugees in camps in Germany have received threats of rape and death and have suffered attacks at the hands of Muslims with whom they live. Their pleas for protection and separation have gone largely ignored. Open Doors, an NGO helping persecuted Christians, noted in a recent report that, of nearly 800 who have been attacked, only 17% reported the incidents for fear of repercussions. After seeing more threats of beheading and rape, one center has recently separated the Christians and hired Christians to supervise them—and there have been no more attacks. Similar situations exist in other camps in Europe. Please intercede for those who remain faithful to Jesus, for their safety, spiritual growth, and testimony. May they be instruments to bring others to Him. Pray that more camps would respond to the plight of those who are harassed for their faith; those who are former Muslims are most targeted.

2016 World Watch List: Azerbaijan 34/50*

Azerbaijan lies on the Caspian Sea in Western Asia and is a former Soviet republic. It is officially a secular state, but some 85% of its people follow Islam. Of more than 9.7 million people, fewer than 20,000 are evangelical Christians They and mainstream Christians are considered "extremists" and a threat to the State, so churches are carefully watched and must submit reports on their activities and finances. Muslims who accept Jesus face great pressure from their families and communities to renounce their faith. Pray for our Azeri brothers and sisters, that they may have opportunities to worship freely and be able to own and distribute Bibles and other Christian materials, which are severely restricted. Pray that Jesus would reveal himself to Muslims in dreams and visions. Intercede for the authorities, that they might find freedom in Jesus.
