Today's Prayer Requests: From Students, Alumni, and Missionaries

BENIN: Pray for two young men who, through their participation in a Jumaa Prayer group in their church, are pursuing God's call to full-time ministry. One has begun his Bible school training; the other is serving an internship with a pastor and will begin Bible school next year. Pray the Lord will bless their studies and ministry, and that He will raise up more who will commit to go to those less reached.

SIERRA LEONE: In a recent conference on the Holy Spirit and missions, the Assemblies of God of Sierra Leone set a goal of opening 250 new churches and sending out 50 home missionaries over the next 4 years. Most of the 14 less-reached people groups here follow Islam. Please pray that the Lord would prepare the way before these missionaries and church planters and work on hearts in advance in resistant communities. Pray for miraculous favor in purchasing land for new works, as this is usually very difficult in these areas.

In the News

Intercede for an Assemblies of God pastor, his wife, and their 9 children on the island of Zanzibar, off the coast of Tanzania. After warning the pastor through leaflets and phone messages to stop evangelizing, suspected Muslim extremists burnt down their home on August 13. No one was injured, but the family lost their home and goods and much of the church's equipment stored there. They are still homeless, sleeping on the floor of the church, and their 9-month-old baby has contracted pneumonia. 2016 World Watch List: Malaysia*

This island nation in the South China Sea is number 30 in the list of nations where Christians suffer the most persecution. Though Islam is the state religion, Malaysia has been tolerant toward other religions. This is changing, however. Most of the Christians here are ethnic Chinese or Indian, and they have been facing more discrimination on the basis of both race and religion. Malay believers from Muslim families may be excommunicated or sent to camps to be re-indoctrinated into Islam. Pray for our brothers and sisters here, that they would stand firm in their faith.
