Today's Prayer Requests: From Students, Alumni, and Missionaries

CAMEROON: An alumnus working in a northern region of this nation writes, "I need your prayers. This part of the country is very insecure, so pray for our safety, for stability in the country, and divine accompaniment for the accomplishment of our mission." *Muslim insurgents are active in this area and target churches and Christians*.

LIBERIA: Pray for Liberian workers who are in training to plant Assemblies of God churches among several people groups who have had very little witness among them, particularly three Muslim-majority tribes near Guinea and Sierra Leone. In the past, workers among them have had to leave for lack of resources, but new workers will be sent with more oversight and support. Pray that the Lord would prepare hearts in these areas as these new church planters prepare themselves.

SUB-SAHARAN AFRICA: This coming week general superintendents and delegates are joining together for meetings of the continent-wide Africa Assemblies of God Alliance. Islam dominates in some of their countries and is growing in others. Please pray for these leaders as they meet, that they may have opportunities to address this reality and to hear from one another about the challenges Islam poses around the continent. Pray that the Lord would give each one a greater burden for and divine guidance in developing strategies to reach their Muslim neighbors. May He use them to mobilize the churches in each nation to pray for and boldly seek to win the unreached.

2017 World Watch List: Pakistan (4/50)*

Located in South Asia, on the northwest border of India, Pakistan ranks 4th in the list of nations where Christians face the greatest persecution. The government as well as militant Islamist groups such as the Taliban make it difficult for those who follow Jesus. Each year hundreds of Christian girls are kidnapped and forced into Muslim marriages. Believers are sometimes charged with blasphemy against the Prophet or the Koran; some have been killed despite their innocence. Churches are monitored and can be shut down.
