The 2018 World Watch List is now available at https://www.opendoorsusa.org/christian-persecution/world-watch-list/. This list ranks the 50 countries where Christians face the most persecution and is published each year by Open Doors, an organization that monitors and serves the persecuted Church, In 36 of the 50 nations listed, Islam is the dominant religion. The list offers a profile and prayer requests for each country. Let's remember our brothers and sisters in these nations throughout the year.

Please pray for Evangelical churches in Malaysia. A coalition of Islamic organizations proposed a ban on "evangelical" Christianity. Of Malaysia's 31 million people, 56% are Muslims.

Open Their Eyes

Muslims are taught that their holy book, the Koran, is the miraculous and final word of God. They hold that the Koran exists in its original language and has remained unchanged for 1,400 years, while the Bible has been altered and exists in multiple translations and languages. Children memorize the Koran in the original Arabic, whether they understand the language or not. Islamic teachers interpret the words of Allah, and followers are not to question ideas they do not comprehend. When a Muslim reads the Bible, he or she may approach it with suspicion and even fear. Let's pray that the Holy Spirit would grip the hearts of Muslims with the conviction that they are reading the very words of Truth, leading to salvation and eternal life.
