Today's Prayer Requests: From Students, Alumni, and Missionaries

LIBERIA: An alumnus shares several needs in predominately-Muslim areas of Liberia:

- Pray for resources to build an Assemblies of God primary school in a particular town, where parents have expressed a desire and willingness to send their children to a good Christian school.
- Pray for the pastors and churches in this area, that through reaching children, they can reach whole families. Parents will not come to church but are happy to send their children. May the salvation and testimonies of these little ones touch them.
- Pray for strength and resources for a home missions couple working in a strongly Muslim county. Over the years, mothers have brought children to them, especially girls and often by night, then leave with no way to contact them. This couple now has more than 50 children living in their compound. Their own young-adult children and other believers serve as teachers for these young ones, some of whom are now in middle school.
- A well drilled in one Muslim village produced water for a few days, then stopped. Though a letter of guarantee was signed, the company refuses to try to correct this. Pray that the Lord would provide a resolution to this situation in His way, so that these people may have water and come to know the Living Water.
- Pray for a spiritual breakthrough among the more resistant tribes in the western part of Liberia.

NIGERIA: A student asks us to continue praying for the worsening conflict in his nation, as Muslim Fulani herdsman continue to target Christians. In the past two weeks, two pastors in his area have been killed.

Just this week Nigeria's Central Bank was ordered to stop any foreign exchange that would allow food to be imported, in a move to stimulate local agriculture. At the same time, however, instability caused by the above-mentioned conflict already threatens crop production in many areas. Herdsmen have forced many farmers to abandon their fields, and their cattle destroy crops and overgraze the land. Pray for God's intervention in this situation.

TOGO: A student pastoring in a Muslim-majority city is working with church members to produce Bible-based video dramas to show locally and to share on the Internet. People will not come to church because of social pressure, he explains, but they enjoy such presentations and can watch them in the privacy of their own home. Please pray that these productions would touch many lives.
