World Watch List 2020: Uzbekistan (18/50)*

Islam first came to this Central Asian area in the 8th century and was adopted by the Mongol rulers in the 14th century. Under the rule of the U.S.S.R., mosques were closed and religious teaching stopped. Uzbekistan gained independence in 1991, and today its 33 million people live under an authoritarian government that favors Islam. The Eastern Orthodox and some other mainstream churches are tolerated, as they do not seek to reach Uzbeks. Evangelical and Pentecostal churches, however, are considered a threat to both the government and to Muslim society. Believers are often under surveillance and forbidden to share their faith, and Christian literature is confiscated. A Muslim who chooses to follow Christ faces possible house arrest and beatings from the family and community. Please pray

- that the Lord would encourage His people here and give them opportunities for fellowship and discipleship;
- for the few workers among the Uzbek people, for favor, protection, and open doors of ministry;
- that God would work in the hearts of the government leaders, that they may uphold the right to freedom of worship their constitution guarantees.
