Today's Prayer Requests: *From Students, Alumni, and Workers*

BURKINA FASO: An Assemblies of God pastor shares this report and these prayer requests from his area:

- The AG Bible school is situated on the edge of the red zone, where terrorist activity is rampant. It is still functioning, by the grace of God. **Pray that this and the nine other AG Bible schools in Burkina can continue to operate and train pastors, and for the safety of students and staff.**
- “There are many refugees in [our town]. Pastors from [several towns] are here now and are being supported by the national church and the regions. But thanks to your prayers, the situation is improving. Others are returning to where they were.” **Praise God that, after many months and even years, some pastors are able to return to their homes and churches! Pray for their safety and for great harvests in their respective towns and villages.**
- “We are just 20 km [12 miles] from where attacks have occurred, but just this past week we have begun the construction of our church building in spite of this fact.” **Pray that God’s hand would be on this project, and for protection and resources.**

SIERRA LEONE: Work continues on the construction of the Bible school in an interior city of this Muslim-majority nation. A worker reports that they hope to finish building in March. The campus consists of a chapel, classrooms, offices, a library, three dorms, round cement huts, and block lean-to structure for student cooking, and can accommodate some 90 students. Please pray

- for the safe and timely completion of the construction;
- that the Holy Spirit would touch the hearts of the local workers, many of whom are Muslim, as each day they study the life of Abraham and have a prayer time with the team;
- for wisdom for the national church leaders as they staff and open the school.

WAAST: Pray for the WAAST graduation, to be held this Saturday, December 5. Due to the COVID-19 restrictions this year, the Class of 2020 is much smaller than usual (34 + 2 in the doctoral program), and the typical crowds will not be attending. Pray for these new alumni as they return to their homes and ministries. Many work in Muslim-dominated areas; pray they would leave with an ever-growing burden to reach their neighbors and to teach their members to intercede for and reach out to them.
