World Watch List 2021: Pakistan (5/50)*

Sandwiched between Afghanistan and India, the Islamic Republic of Pakistan is home to more than 230 million people. The government strictly upholds the state religion, and harsh blasphemy laws criminalize any words or actions that would insult the Prophet Mohammad or Islam. Those who decide to follow Jesus are often accused—usually falsely—of blasphemy and jailed, fined, tortured, even killed. Christians are given the most demeaning or dangerous jobs and treated as second-class citizens. Churches exist in Pakistan, but are monitored, and Christians who share their faith with others are harassed or worse. Girls and women are especially vulnerable to kidnapping, rape, and forced marriage and conversion to Islam. Please pray

- that the Lord would grant His children in Pakistan strength, patience, and joy as they serve and often suffer for Him;
- for divine opportunities for believers to share their faith, and for boldness and wisdom as they do so;
- that Muslims who are seeking the truth would see Jesus in dreams or visions;
- for God's protection for women and girls who face abuse, and that He would work in the hearts of their abusers to bring them to Himself.
