In the News

Unrest erupted again this week in **Chad** as protests against the military regime’s transitional government resulted in five deaths. The head of the army and the Transitional Military Council is the son of the late president, who was killed April 19 after 30 years in power, and many are decrying the continuation of his dynasty. Please continue to pray

- for peace and for wisdom for those responsible for the transition back to civilian government, and for the future president;
- for continued religious freedom in this majority-Muslim nation;
- that the Lord would use His people to lead fearful, frustrated people to the lasting peace only He can give.

World Watch List 2021: India (10/50)*

The Southern Asian nation of India, with nearly 1.4 billion people, is the birthplace and epicenter of Hinduism. More than 80% of its people are Hindus. Some 14%—nearly 200 million—follow Islam, the largest minority religion. More than 10% of the world’s Muslims live in India. These religions, one worshiping many gods, the other monotheistic, are diametrically opposed, and extremists on both sides fight aggressively to defend their faith. Incidents of Hindu-Muslim violence are common. About 2% of the population claim to be Christians, and evangelical churches are growing. Those who choose to follow Jesus, whether from Hindu or Muslim families, face severe persecution from family and community. Please pray

- that followers of Jesus, through their lives and quiet witness, would show Truth to those who seek God and the meaning of life elsewhere, and find divine opportunities to explain the gospel;
- for the nation as it faces a devastating second wave of COVID-19, with an average of nearly 2,700 deaths recorded every day, and shortages of beds, oxygen, and vaccines;
- for Muslim (and Hindu!) seekers, that they may see Jesus revealed, and for new believers to find fellowship. Many are isolated due to fear and/or geography and have no Christian friends.
