Today's Prayer Requests and Praise Reports: From Students, Alumni, and Workers

CAMEROON: Please continue to pray for God's intervention in the war-torn North West and South West Regions of Cameroon. For the past 6 years, separatists have been calling for the formation of a new nation, and hundreds of thousands are suffering as they kill, kidnap, and terrorize cities and villages to accomplish their ends. While most in these regions claim Christianity or traditional religions, there is a sizable Muslim population as well. Please pray

- that the Lord would move among the Fulani people of these regions. According to an alumnus, the government has armed many of these people so they can rout out and kill separatists hidden in villages. They do so, but often go on to seize the villages and the land for their cattle, leaving the people homeless.
- for people who have lost their homes and have moved deep into the forests for safety. Many are believers. Pray that they would have opportunities to share Jesus with Muslims and others around them who are seeking hope and peace.

HORN OF AFRICA: Most of the nations in the Horn of Africa (Djibouti, Eritrea, Ethiopia, and Somalia) have a Muslim majority and restrict evangelism. A worker in East Africa shares these reports and requests from this region:

- In one nation, the door was once open to workers to minister, but is now closing due to unrest in the region. Pray for believers here, that the Lord would use them to reach their neighbors with the Good News during this time of crisis.
- In this same nation, an estimated 500 Christians are being held for their faith. Some Pentecostal pastors have been in prison for 17-18 years. Pray that the Lord would sustain and use them, and for their release.
- In another country, 38 workers from these four nations received Bible school training between 2013-2017. Unfortunately, this has not been able to continue. Pray for these workers as they sow seeds in their respective lands. One is leading an underground congregation of 20-30 people—a large group in his country.
- In a third nation, a team of workers is making plans to establish themselves near a certain unreached tribe. Pray that the Lord would go before them, prepare hearts to receive their message, and guide them in His perfect will and time.

LIBERIA: This past Saturday 18 students graduated from Liberia Assemblies of God Bible College, according to the director, a WAAST alumnus. Some of these new pastors will be posted, while others already hold positions in churches. Please pray

- for those who will be posted to or who already work in the Muslim areas of the country, that the Lord would give them wisdom, favor, and fruit;
- for "one of our female graduates... a convert from Islam. All her family, except her converted late father, are still Muslims. She needs prayer as she still faces opposition from family members."
