In the News

BURKINA FASO: A military coup attempt that began this past Sunday, January 23, has succeeded in ousting the president, dissolving the government, and suspending the constitution. The takeover occurred after months of protests against the government's ineffectiveness at containing the spread of terrorism. When the previous president was ousted in 2014, jihadist groups, some linked to Al-Qaida and to Islamic State in the Greater Sahara, took advantage of the instability and entrenched themselves in Burkina, especially in the north and east. According to one report, by January 2018, 8,000 people had been displaced by the conflict; today that number has grown to 1.5 million. Let's pray

- for stability in the coming days; for the moment all seems calm;
- for wisdom for the now-ruling junta leader and his forces as they lead, and for their salvation;
- for the many churches and believers, that people would see in them the stability and peace that they desperately need, and turn to Jesus;
- that jihadists' plans to spread radical Islam still further in Burkina would be thwarted, and that they would have encounters with the True God.

World Watch List 2022: Afghanistan (1/50)*

North Korea has been at the top of the World Watch List for the past 20 years. But with the takeover of the Taliban this past August, Afghanistan is now the country where Jesus followers face the greatest persecution. The Taliban requires strict adherence to Islamic beliefs and customs. Even before the takeover, anyone found to be a Christian, or seeking to leave Islam, was disowned or killed by the family or clan. Now the Taliban actively hunt them down, going door to door, using documents that reveal names of suspects. Men are immediately killed, and women are forced to marry or are raped. Please pray

- for Afghan believers, that God's peace would overwhelm and encourage them, and for their protection;
- for the Taliban leaders, that they may have a divine revelation of Jesus, and that their hearts would be softened toward their people;
- for Afghans refugees who are being resettled in free lands. Pray that they would meet true believers who will introduce them to Jesus.
