Today's Prayer Requests: From Students, Alumni, and Workers

BURKINA FASO: Please pray for an Assemblies of God Bible school in a town in northern Burkina Faso. According to an alumnus, several years ago the students and staff had to abandon the campus due to ongoing terrorist activity, and jihadists are currently using it as a base camp. The school continues to meet in a town further south. Although another AG school is located is this town, the students from the northern school are meeting separately, ready to return to their own campus as soon as possible. Let's pray

- that the jihadists living on the Bible school grounds would find salvation in Jesus in that place;
- that the campus would be freed and restored to the school, allowing the students to return to study and minister in that area.

MALI: A graduate pastoring in the restive central region of Mali is holding special prayer meetings in his church this week, with "preaching and prayer for healing, deliverance, and restoration." He has invited two other local churches—and especially people who do not yet know the God who answers prayer! He writes, "Help us pray that all will go well and that Jesus will glorify His name." Pray for the Lord's protection over all the participants, and that many will be saved, healed, delivered and restored!

NIGERIA: A student serving here writes, "Churches in the north are under attack. They need our prayers [especially in several towns in Borno State, Plateau State, and Kaduna State]. Pray for God's protection and sustenance of the missionaries/pastors and their families."

SENEGAL: Pray for the Casamance, made up of two small regions of Senegal located below The Gambia and thus separated from most of the nation. For decades, the people of this fertile area have felt both neglected and exploited, and rebels have been fighting off and on for land rights and even separation from the rest of Senegal—a conflict that continues today. A WAAST professor who has served in Senegal shares two requests:

- Pray for workers to serve in the Casamance. There are currently just four AG churches. The Assemblies of God of France has made preparations to send a couple in 2022 or 2023—but to date no one has offered to go.
- Pray for a spiritual breakthrough among the Susu people in the Casamance. For a Susu, says this professor, it is unimaginable to become a Christian; he would lose his identity and face total rejection.

The Assemblies of God of Côte d'Ivoire has sent two missionaries to serve in the Casamance. Pray the Lord would use them in great ways to encourage and build up the Church here.
