Today's Prayer Requests: *From Students, Alumni, and Workers*

GHANA: An alumnus working in a city in central Ghana asks us to pray for the thousands of girls who come there from the northern areas to work. Known as *Kayoyos*, these young ladies, equipped with a large basin, eke out a hard living carrying heavy loads on their heads for people, in the markets or on the streets. “The majority of them are Muslims,” he explains, “and the tribes they come from are among the unreached people groups of Ghana. Some are deceived by their peers into moving to the city. Some come in search of money to take care of their families back home. They stay in the slums and most of them sleep in the streets. Most are abused. Most of them are raped. My wife and I have worked with some of them before and have a burden to reach them. We need divine direction.” *Pray that the Holy Spirit would grant this couple wisdom and open doors of opportunity to reach these young ladies with the hope of Jesus.*

GUINEA-CONAKRY: *Praise God*, an alumnus working in central Guinea reports that this past Sunday 27 people were baptized in water. This area is populated largely by the staunchly Muslim Fulani, but some are finding new life in Jesus! This worker shares the following requests:

- Pray for the construction of more classrooms for the primary school in the town where this worker serves. The four existing classrooms are filled with kindergarten and first-grade students. Pray for the teachers as they touch these young lives.
- Pray for the various projects of the church in this town, that God would use the members to touch still more people at their point of need, and point them to the Savior.
- Pray for the installation of a new pastor, a recent Bible school graduate, in a work on the Guinea-Senegal border. May the Lord give him wisdom and favor in this community, and fruitful ministry.

SENSITIVE COUNTRY: A few weeks ago we prayed for a young lady who has been meeting with a female Christian worker. This young lady is engaged to become the second wife of a man 20 years older. Please continue to pray for her. The workers are noticing a change in her behavior and mannerisms that seems to indicate a leaning to a more conservative Islam. “Pray she will yield to the Holy Spirit and desire to seek truth. Pray for wisdom for [two workers] as they talk to her. They need to find the heart question she is asking.”
