Today's Prayer Requests: From Students, Alumni, and Workers

GUINEA-CONAKRY: A student from this Muslim-majority nation asks us to pray for the salvation of his in-laws, who continue to follow Islam.

Pray for a worker from Togo who is leaving soon with his family to take up the ministry of a returning worker. Pray for a smooth transition and integration for them and for favor and good relationships with the townspeople and ministry colleagues.

CHILDREN IN MUSLIM AREAS: An alumnae involved in children's ministry shares how God uses children to reach their families: In the Muslim-dominated part of her country, Cameroon, a pastor ran a children's club, but had no church, as the adults were resistant. One father was very sick, and his young son claimed that if he would come to the pastor's house for prayer, God would heal him. The desperate man finally agreed to go and was carried to the house. Children gathered around to pray—and he walked out, healed. From that time on he told his wife and children and other adults to visit this pastor, and a church was started that is still growing. However, the father himself fears persecution and to this day has not given his life to the Lord. Please pray he would find the same peace and joy in Jesus that his family and others have found. Thank God for the families that have accepted the Lord; pray that many more may come to Him.

This alumnae also asks us to pray for children in the **North African nations: Morocco, Algeria, Libya, Tunisia, and Egypt.** Bibles and Christian ministries are illegal or highly restricted in these nations. However, many parents send their young children to other countries for schooling, she explains, "so they are with our kids. If our kids are strong and witness to them, they can learn about Jesus." Please pray

- for North African children studying in schools in nations where they can freely hear the gospel, that they may find Christian friends and teachers who can lead them to Jesus and help them grow in their faith.
- that these children would be exposed to the TRUE gospel. There are many false doctrines presented as the "gospel," she points out. "It is a shame when someone has an opportunity to hear, and he hears a lie."
- that the Lord would use these children to bring their parents to the Lord.
- that parents in these closed nations would become more open to outsiders; many fear allowing their children to talk to anyone outside their community, making it difficult for foreign believers to present the Good News to them.

MADAGASCAR: An alumnae from this island nation writes: "Jumaa Prayer is ever in our hearts! We do not cease to pray for our Muslim friends [using these prayer requests] every Friday." While most Malagasy claim to be Christians, the Antakarana, an indigenous tribe numbering over 200,000, follow Islam, often mixed with traditional practices, and nine other immigrant people groups on the island are Muslim. *Pray that the Lord would raise up more intercessors and workers in Madagascar, that these largely unreached peoples might know the Way to salvation.*
