Today's Prayer Requests: *From Students, Alumni, and Workers*

BENIN: On November 25, soldiers in Benin responded to two terrorist attacks in the north, and to another on Wednesday, November 30. Assemblies of God workers are serving in at least two of the affected communities. Most of the tribes in northern Benin consider themselves Muslims, and the new works are growing very slowly. Please pray for the protection of these workers, and that God would use them to lead many who are living in fear to peace in Jesus.

SENEGAL: A worker serving with a ministry team in this Muslim nation shares three prayer requests:

- “Pray for [a male student who attends classes at the team’s English center]. He stopped by the center last night. [Two workers] and he had a great talk. He is open to reading the Bible.”
- Pray for a young lady who is learning God’s Word with a lady worker. “Pray she would receive truth and freedom.”
- “The mayor of [the section of the city where these workers are serving] wants to meet with [the team leader] to discuss partner options. Pray we would have the wisdom of God to minister in this community to bring people to Jesus.”

Praise God for the seeds being sown here and for favor. Pray that the Lord would encourage these workers as they minister patiently to seekers one by one.

SPAIN: Last month we prayed for a Farsi-speaking (Iranian) group of young believers who were just beginning to meet. A worker reports that their pastor continues to follow up with them, and various ones have met several more times at this worker’s home to eat together and watch and discuss videos concerning the biblical prophets and the life of the Messiah. Please pray

- that this small group would persevere and that each person would grow in his or her faith;
- for wisdom for this pastor as he discipled them;
- that the Lord would use these believers to share Jesus with other Iranians. Many Iranians, disillusioned with Islam, reject religion altogether and embrace the secularism dominant in Spain/Western Europe.

Please continue to pray that the Lord would provide a pastor for an Arabic-speaking church plant in Madrid. A potential pastor will be visiting soon; pray that God’s will would be clear and that this church can move forward.

TOGO: Pray for evangelistic meetings currently being held (December 1-3) at the stadium in Lomé. Pray that many seekers, including Muslims, will find what they are looking for in Jesus. Pray that they may be followed up and discipled and become a vital part of the Body of Christ and of a local fellowship.

In light of the growing terrorist threat in the coastal countries of West Africa, including Togo, pray for security during these meetings.
