Today's Prayer Requests: *From Workers*

MALI: *We thank God* that many schools and universities have been able to reopen in Mali, at least in the cities, after a two-week closure. The al-Qaida-linked terrorist group JNIM has blocked roads and destroyed hundreds of tanker trucks taking fuel to the capital city, causing a severe shortage and prompting the closure. This past week several convoys under military escort arrived, bringing some relief. Please continue to pray that God would intervene and thwart JNIM's ongoing effort to paralyze the nation and spread Islam. Pray that many would be open to the message of the gospel in these difficult times.

MOZAMBIQUE: Since October 5, 2017, people in Mozambique's northernmost province have suffered attacks and displacement as local terrorists, known as al-Shabaab, seek to spread Islam in this majority-Christian land. In 2019, al-Shabaab pledged allegiance to the Islamic State and now operates as Islamic State–Mozambique (ISM). Over the past few months, ISM has steadily expanded its territory, moving further south. Let's intercede for Mozambique.

- Pray for God's protection over civilians, especially Christians, who are preferred targets for killing, abduction, and recruitment. Many have lost their homes and livelihoods and had to flee several times over the years.
- Pray for children. So far in 2025, ISM has kidnapped more than 120 children from their schools or churches. They use them as fighters or servants, then often release them when they become too weak to work. For many of these children, churches become safe havens as authorities work to reunite them with their families. Pray for their safety and healing from trauma, and that many would find the loving Savior, Jesus.
- Pray for the salvation of Muslims—including the jihadists. One pastor says, "Yes, we are persecuted, but many Muslims are accepting Jesus." May they become rooted in Him and share Him with others.

In the News: New York City

On November 4, voters in the largest US city elected as mayor Zohran Mamdani. Mamdani is an outspoken Shia Muslim as well as a member of the Democratic Socialists of America, and his victory is being hailed joyfully by Muslims around the world. Pray for him as he assumes his duties in January. Pray that the Holy Spirit would influence his leadership, and work in his heart to draw him to the true God.
