Today’s Prayer Requests: *From Workers*

CHAD: A worker from this African nation shares the following requests:

- Pray for two Chadian workers serving among Chadian Arabs. This people group, the largest in the nation, is semi-nomadic and very closed to interaction with other groups and to the gospel. Pray that these workers would see a spiritual breakthrough and lead many into the Kingdom.
- Pray for more workers, from both Chad and from other nations, to care for existing churches and further the work. According to this worker, his church organization has some 150 pastors, but many more congregations, many of whom lack a full-time pastor.
- Pray for open doors to begin new works in the cities; most churches are in villages.
- Pray for the Bible school in the Christian-majority south, with about 18 students. Many graduates from this school are now serving in Muslim-dominated areas; pray that these newly equipped workers would join them.

WEST & CENTRAL AFRICA: On Saturday, November 22, 133 students from 14 nations in West and Central Africa will receive their diplomas from West Africa Advanced School of Theology in Togo. Many of these pastors and leaders attended Jumaa Prayer meetings during this semester and express a growing burden for our “cousins.” As they return to their homes and ministries, pray that God would use them, in the words of one graduate, “to create a burden in his servants’ hearts to reach Muslims” and to establish intercessory prayer groups in the churches they lead.

In the News: Pakistan

This past June, we praised God for the passing of the Child Marriage Restraint Bill, setting the marriage age at 18, at least in the capital city. We also prayed that this bill would be passed and enforced in more areas and even at the national level. *We thank God* that the bill has now been adopted in Balochistan Province. The law aims to curb early marriage, the forced conversion of Christian girls to Islam for the purpose of marriage, and the trafficking of girls (especially non-Muslims) for marriage to much older men—all-too-common practices in Pakistan. Two more provinces still need to adopt this bill; in one, it has been pending for more than a year. Pray that the Child Marriage Restraint Bill will become national law and that it will be strictly enforced.
