Today's Prayer Requests: *From Workers*

GUINEA-CONAKRY: Last week, a Bible school campus hosted more than 600 children for a children's camp—many of them from Muslim families. The dean of the school reports, "God blessed the children and many gave their life to Jesus, and many were also visited by the Holy Spirit." He asks us to pray

- "that the teachings the children received will remain in their hearts and bear fruit to the glory of God;
- "that the children's ministry would continue to develop in the churches in Guinea,
- "that the children's workers would prove themselves capable; many of them are new to this ministry;
- "that many of the teenagers who have been called into the ministry would respond favorably to this call."

About 90% of Guinea's people follow Islam, but churches are free to meet and reach out. "God continues to work in Guinea and we are sincerely grateful to Him."

MALI: In their continuing efforts to gain control of northern Mali, the Tuareg separatist group FLA and the al-Qaida-linked group JNIM ambushed a military convoy on Saturday, July 18, killing at least 50 Malian soldiers and Russian Africa Corps partners and kidnapping some 20 others. While the army responded quickly and neutralized some terrorists, its control of the area is tenuous. Please pray for God's intervention in this situation and in the lives of the jihadists.

Pray for a church in a town in this same region, where there are very few churches. The pastor passed away a few weeks ago, and his widow and children have relocated. Please pray

- for this widow and her children, that they would find strength, comfort, and healing in the Lord and within the community of believers that surrounds them;
- for the new pastor sent to continue this work and for the congregation, that the Lord would encourage and protect them and help them to grow in unity and unwavering faith in Christ as they serve Him in this unstable area of the country.

MOROCCO: After nearly 30 years of work, a Moroccan translation team has completed and is printing the full Bible in Darija (Moroccan Arabic). This unique dialect of Arabic mixes in Berber, French, and Spanish terms and is the most widely used language in daily life, with some 35 million speakers. "Many Christians can't wait to read God's Word in their heart language, to understand it better and share it with the rest of the country," says a worker. Let's pray

- for open doors and creative strategies for churches and believers to distribute copies of God's Word in Darija to those hungry to read it, and for divine favor to access places and people who are normally difficult to reach;
- that the audio form of this Bible would reach and bless those who cannot read; more than 35% of people in rural areas are illiterate;
- that Christ-followers would gain greater understanding of His Word and grow stronger in faith and witness.
